



# BADGERS CREEK

## Shiraz - Cabernet

**Designation:** AUSTRALIAN RED WINE

**Grape varieties:** Blend of Shiraz (some variety as the Sirah) and Cabernet Sauvignon which makes this wine typical.

**Origin:** This wine comes from the major wine areas between Adelaide and Melbourne (Southern Australia). Mainly from the Munay Darling region.

**Vinification:** The grapes are picked when fully mature, destemmed, crushed and fermented for 8 to 12 days. Frequent pumping releases the color of the film. The fermentation temperature is controlled (max. 90° F), followed by a soft pressing. The wine is raked, filtered and bottled.

**Soil:** Very variable over the whole production area, there are sandy, clay-chalky and slaty soils.

**Tasting notes:**

- **Color:** Ruby red, intense and clear.
- **Nose:** Notes of spices, cherries, blackcurrants, green peppers, liquorice and light wooded.
- **Palate:** Round wine with supple tannins, good persistence.

**Recommendations:** This wine is ideal with red meat, pork meat, salad and great number of cheeses.

**Serving condition in F°:** 61 - 64

**Alcohol content:** 13.5

**Cellar potential:** 2 - 3 years

**Bottle capacity:** 750 ML
