






Designation: VIN DE PAYS D'OC RED

**Grape varieties:** 100% Merlot which produces very varietal wines and powerful aromas. Originates from the Bordeaux winegrowing region and well acclimatized to the terroirs in the south of France (over 68,000 ha).

**Origin:** Geographic location: The Vin de Pays d'Oc winegrowing region is omnipresent in Languedoc. It extends from the south of the Côtes du Rhône to Carcassonne.

**Vinification:** Grapes harvested at perfect ripeness, destemmed, treaded and fermented for about six to 12 days. The fermentation temperature is regulated so it does not exceed 90°F and the fruit is gently pressed. The wine is then racked, filtered and bottled.

**Soil:** The world's biggest winegrowing region relies on a range of soils: clay-silt and clay-chalk.



- Color: Very intense ruby red.

-Nose: Red fruit, blackcurrants, cherries, raspberry jam.

- Palate: Wine with velvet tannins and a fine long taste.

Recommendations: Perfect to serve with white meats, poultry,

grilled meats and all kinds of cheese.
