Collection Saint-Emilion

Designation : SAINT EMILION AOP RED

Grape varieties: 95% Merlot and 5% Cabernet Franc

Origin: The vineyards of saint Emilion is a wine region near the famous town of Saint Emilion, part of the Bordeaux vineyards, located in the Libournais and corresponding to the AOP Saint Emilion. Saint Emilion is listed as a World Heritage site by the UNESCO. Saint-Emilion is an important wine district in Bordeaux, in terms of both quality and quantity. It is the most prolific of the appellations in the Libournais (the area in the north-east of the Bordeaux region also known as the 'right bank'), and produces some of the most expensive wines in the world. The historic town of Saint-Emilion, is right at the center of the main appellation, just a few miles north of the Dordogne river. It is renowned as much for its wine as for its beautiful buildings and scenery.

Vinification: This wine has been made according to the traditional wine-making with stainless steel lining. This process is very long and lasts 2 to 3 weeks. Once the vinification is done, the wine is grown up in a tank with racking every three months.

Soil: Clay-chalky slopes and sand alluviae terrain

Tasting notes :

- **Color:** Pomegranate with reflections of ruby red.
- **Nose:** Subtle aromas of almonds and roses with a hint of red berries.
- **Palate:** Elegant, fruity finish with light, spicy notes.

Recommendations : Serve with red meat, jugged meat, game, terrine de calf sweetbread with chanterelles, veal chops grand-mère, cheese, wild strawberry tarts.
